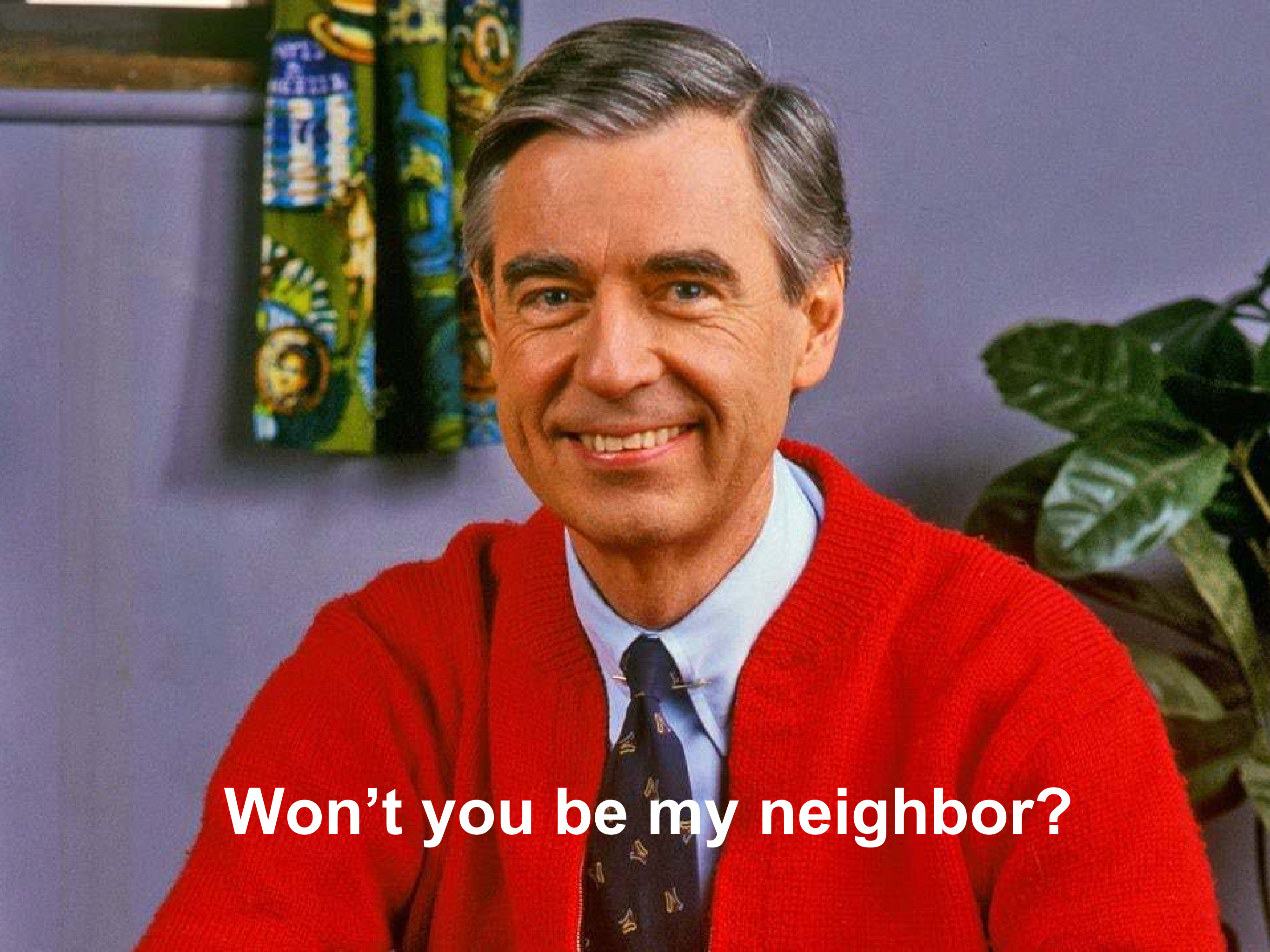
expectations

lab policy

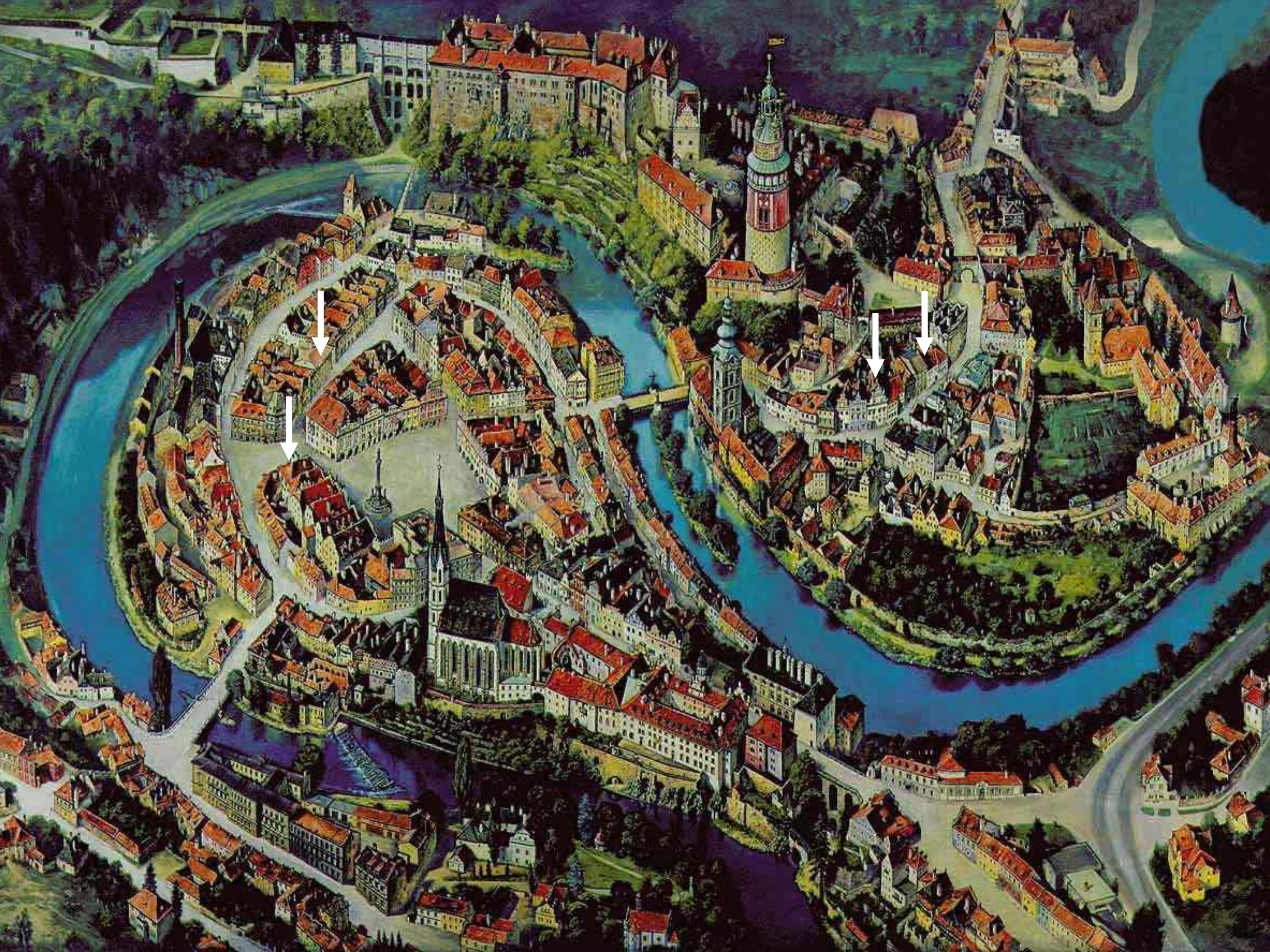
- no food or drink inside the computer hall
