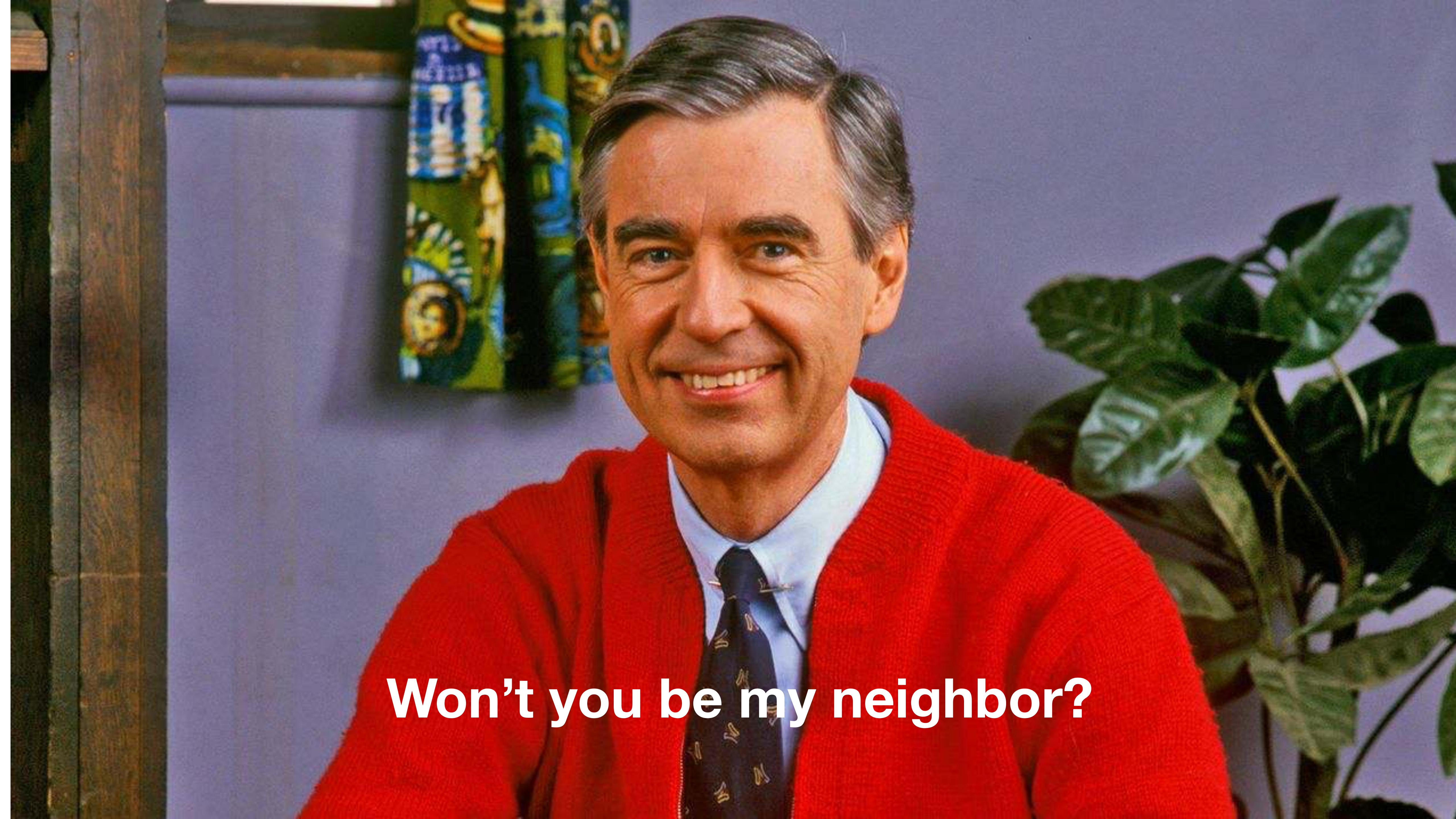
expectations

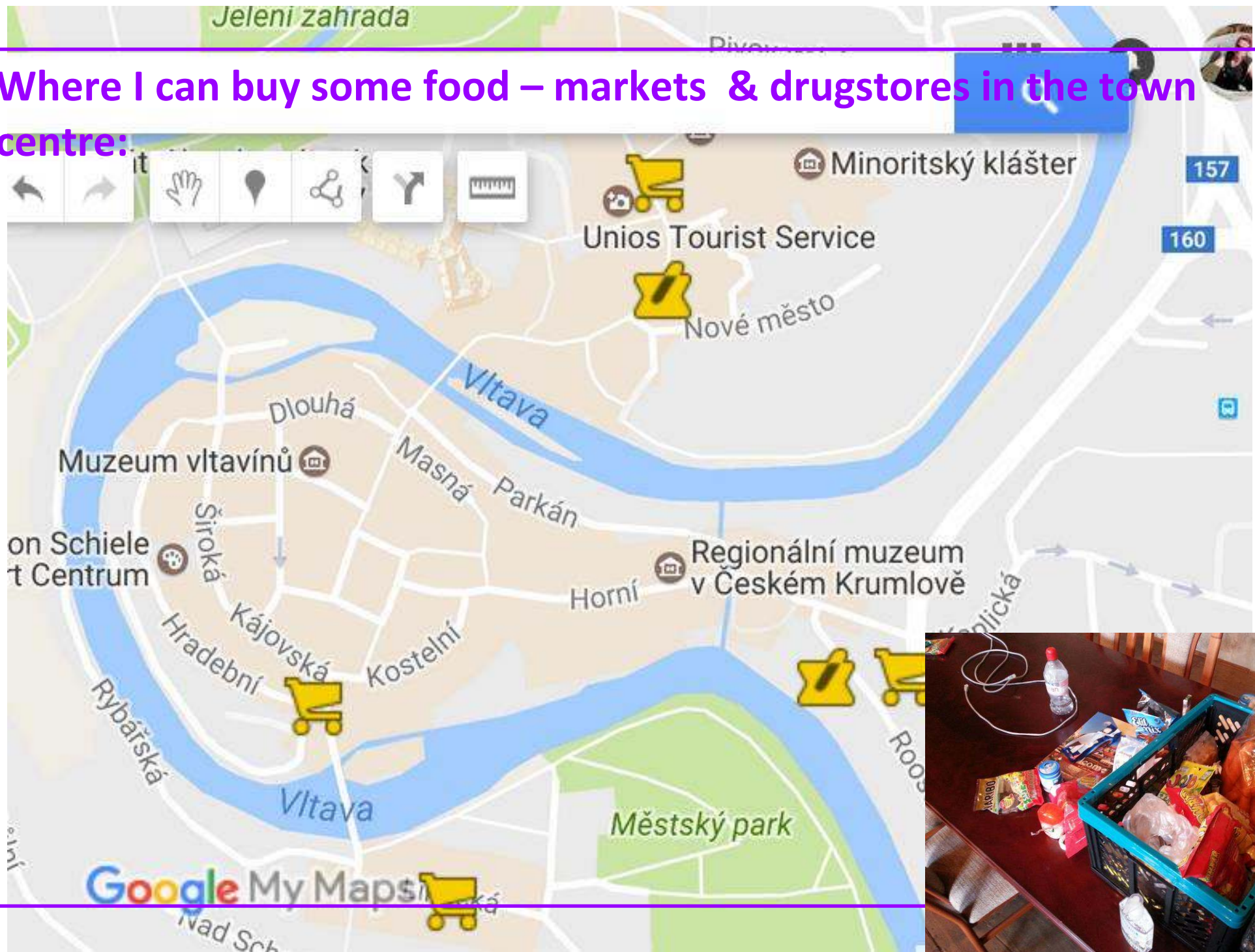

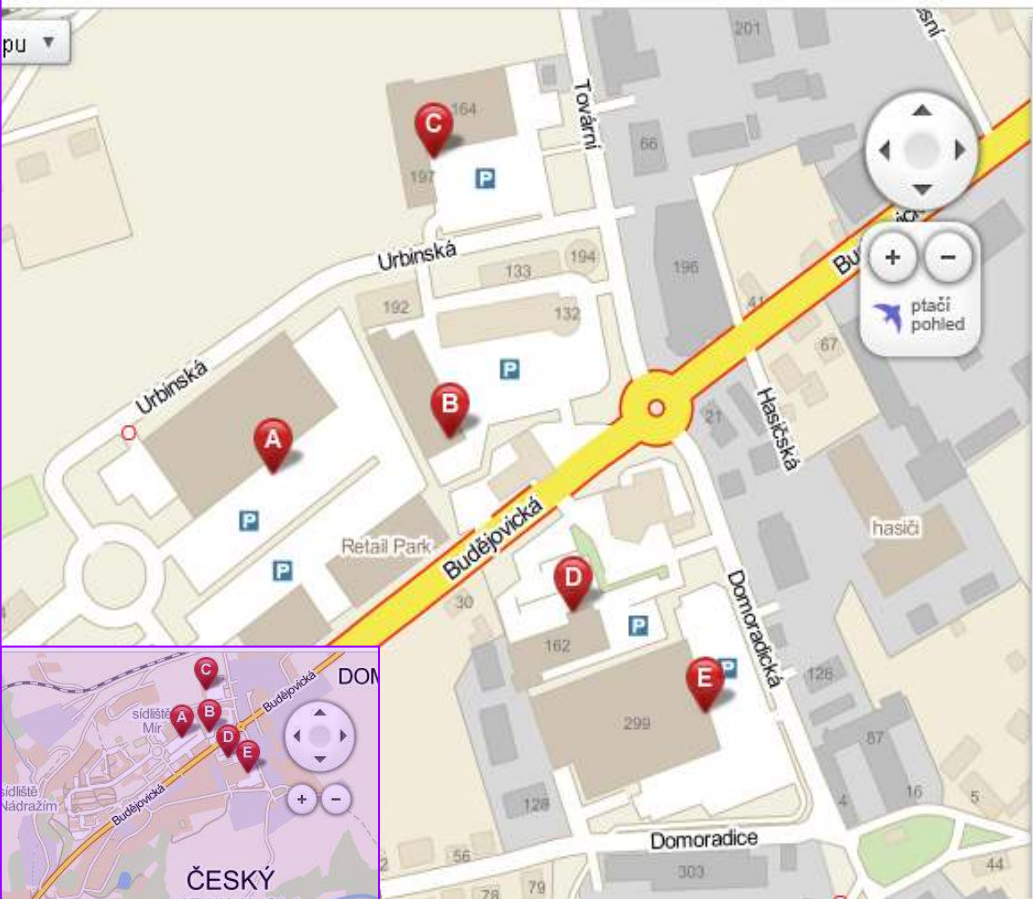

Climb on – Via Ferrata

Just a few minutes' walk from the centre of Český Krumlov, on the right bank of the Vltava River on the rock formation known as Havraní skála (The Raven Rock), is the first Via ferrata. The first route with difficulty C is currently open for more experienced ferratists. If you are new to ferrata climbing, you can book an instructor who will go through the route with you and teach you the skills for safe climbing.

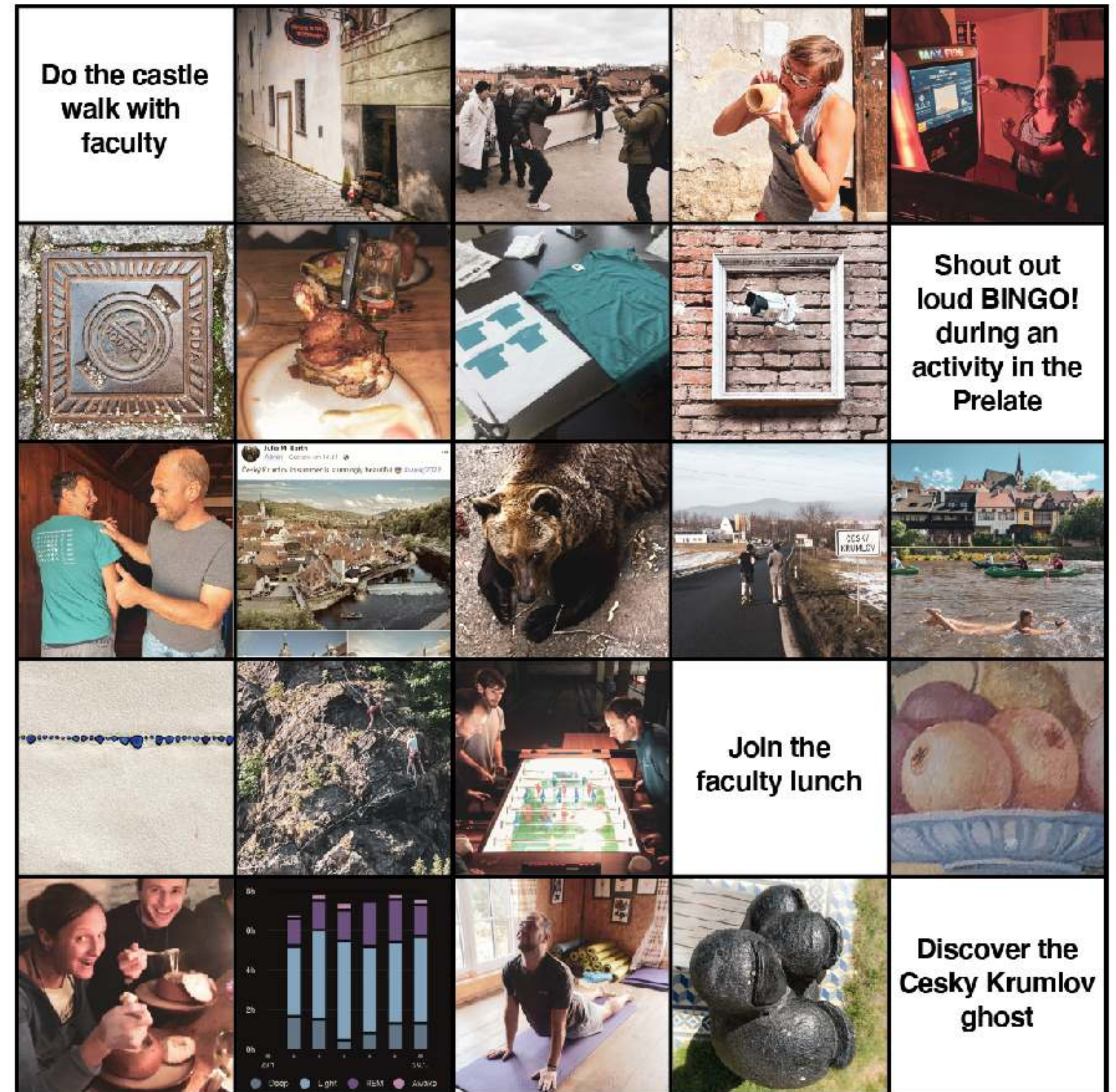

Abstract

With the advent of high-throughput genome sequencing, bioinformatics training has become essential for research in evolutionary biology and related fields. However, individual research groups are often not in the position to teach students about the most up-to-date methodology in the field. To fill this gap, extended bioinformatics courses have been developed by various institutions and provide intense training over the course of two or more weeks. Here, we describe our experience with the organization of a course in one of the longest-running extended bioinformatics series of workshops, the Evomics Workshop on Population and Speciation Genomics that takes place biennially in the UNESCO world heritage town of Český Krumlov, Czech Republic. We list the key ingredients that make this workshop successful in our view, and describe the routine for workshop organization that we have optimized over the years. We report the results of a survey conducted among past workshop participants that quantifies measures of effective teaching and provide examples of how the workshop setting has led to the cross-fertilisation of ideas and ultimately scientific progress.



Dear participants

The Workshop on Population and Speciation Genomics is fast approaching. While the availability of vaccines and other factors led to an easing of Covid restrictions in most countries, the disease is still circulating and many of you might have been wondering about our approach to Covid-related risks. Overall, we hope the workshop is going to be an immersive experience, with many scientific and also social interactions among participants, faculty, and organisers. We believe that these interactions stimulate learning, collaborations, new inspiration, and ultimately scientific progress.

To be able to enjoy the benefits of the workshop, please read and take seriously the following guidelines. Covid mitigation/guidelines:

- 1) All participants are fully vaccinated. This has been checked during registration.
- 2) We strongly encourage everyone to take a Covid test on the day before departure. If you test positive, please do not come to Cesky Krumlov! Inform us and your course fee will be fully refunded. We are not going to enforce this as a rule, but please do take the pre-departure test, especially if you don't feel a 100%. If you arrive to Cesky Krumlov with Covid and spread it around you may ruin the entire workshop for many others.
- 3) We strongly encourage wearing masks during the group indoor learning activities (e.g., in the House of Prelate). This is especially important at the beginning.
- 4) We will attempt to mitigate the risks in the organisation: e.g., we will endeavour to organise social program outdoors rather than indoors where possible.
- 5) Masks and tests will be available from the organisers.
- 6) We will especially encourage (but not enforce) at least one test shortly after arrival (e.g., 3 or 4 days after travel) ... please do this for the benefit of the entire workshop.

We also note that the laws of the Czech Republic require anyone diagnosed with Covid to isolate a minimum of 7 days. In the unfortunate case that someone tests positive, we will of course follow the law. We would also help isolated cases with food deliveries etc. and intend to assist isolating participants with some online activities as far as possible if their health allows.

We hope that everyone remains healthy and that we will all enjoy an exciting and stimulating two weeks in Cesky Krumlov. The workshop begins this Sunday, 5th July, at 19:00 with a welcome dinner and reception at Hotel Zlaty Andel on the main square (likely outdoors in front of the hotel). For those who have signed up for UNIX primer, the start is even earlier, at 16:00 in the computer laboratories of the House of Prelate (details will be communicated separately).
